

INDIAN CIOs TO FOCUS ON PROFIT IN FY14, SAYS E&Y

Mumbai, April 28: Indian chief information officers (CIOs) are more likely to focus on improving bottom line and bringing value to the businesses in FY2013-14, according to a study by Ernst and Young (E&Y) and the CIO Klub.

“The findings of the survey over the last five years highlight how CIO priorities have changed... While CIOs help businesses improve the topline, the current economic volatility is pushing them to look within and help businesses increase their bottom line,” according to the fifth annual edition study ‘Enterprise IT trends and investment 2013’.

Due to continued uncertain economic environment, the focus in 2012 shifted to create a lean, agile and resilient IT function.
